GALA EVENING

On Sunday, gala meal will take place at the hotel Best Western de Chavannes-de-Bogis (check the map). It costs 40 Swiss francs or 38 euros per head for the adults (drinks are not included) and 15 Swiss francs or 14 euros per child up to 12 years old.

Vegetarian meals have to be ordered on the registration form.

Be careful, if it's raining, camping-cars couldn't leave the campsite. For participants who live in the campsite, a shuttle will be available to travel from the campsite to the place of gala evening. **Please register you on the registration form.** Dogs can't be taken in the buses and at the gala meal.

CUSTOMS' PASSAGE OF DOGS

1. Protection against rabies

Have your animal vaccinated at least 21 days before entering Switzerland. If a booster vaccination has been given within the validity period of the first vaccination, the waiting period does not apply.

2. Identification

Your animal must be identified - with a microchip or a tattoo (only valid when tattooed before 03.07.2011).

3. Pet ID

The animals must be accompanied by a correctly completed pet ID.

4. Dogs younger than 3 months

Veterinary certificate, stating that the young animals were kept since birth at their birthplace without contact with wild animals. The certificate is not necessary, when the young animals are accompanied by their mother, from which they are still dependent. Cubs younger than 56 days can only be brought over the border, when they are accompanied by their mother or their foster-mother.

5. Choke collar and spikes collar

Spikes collar are forbidden in Switzerland. Choke collar are tolerated only if they are fitted with a stop loop
